1. SuperTeam Challenge

1.1 SuperTeams:

- 1.1.1 All teams have an opportunity to compete in SuperTeam Tournament. Teams will randomly assigned to SuperTeam alliances by drawing of tickets or another system. Teams will have sufficient time to start planning among alliance teams throughout the first three days of individual team competition.
- 1.1.2 Teams can use a different robot from the one in the individual tournament.
- 1.1.3 If inter-robot communication is desired, Teams are allowed to use Bluetooth or ZigBee communication (see 2.2.5).

1.2 Mission:

- 1.2.1 Superteam missions will be revealed at the international event.
- 1.2.2 Teams are expected to come prepared to perform some program and/or electronic modifications that the alliance teams may desire.
