



How to Apply as a Volunteer for

RoboCupJunior

Step 1 — Create an Account

Head to volunteers.junior.robocup.org and click the Sign Up tab. Fill in your details to create your account.

Login screen

Sign Up screen

You will need to provide:

- First Name and Last Name
- Email address — this will be your login and where confirmations are sent
- Password

Click Create Account. You will be asked to verify your email – remember to check spam for emails from **RoboCup Supabase robocupjunior@robocup.org**

You can also use Test Connection on the login page first to verify your network is reaching the portal.



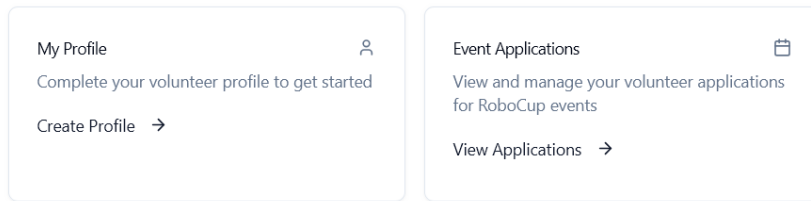
Step 2 — Sign In

Once your account is created, go back to the Login tab, enter your email and password, and click Sign In.

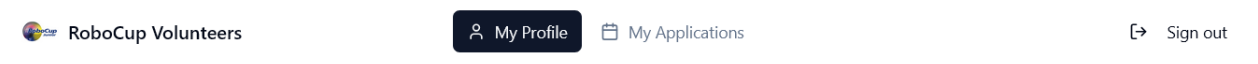


Main dashboard after signing in

You will land on the main dashboard with two cards: My Profile and Event Applications.

Step 3 — Complete Your Profile

Click My Profile (or "Create Profile →" from the dashboard). Your profile is shared with event organisers and league chairs, so fill it in carefully.

- Email (locked — contact support if it needs changing)
- Region — the country you are from
- Gender (optional)
- Year of Birth
- T-Shirt Size
- Tick confirming you are 19 years or older as of the first competition day

i *RoboCupJunior volunteers must be older than 19 years of age as of the first day of competition.*

You'll be asked about your past RoboCup experience, both at international competitions and local or regional events. It's also ok if you're brand new – welcome!

Step 4 — Apply for the Event

Go to My Applications from the navigation bar. Under Available Events you will see:

Click + Apply next to any open events to begin the application form.

Step 5 — Fill In the Application Form

After clicking + Apply, you will be taken through the full application form with several sections to complete.

League Preferences


Select all leagues you have experience with or can support:

- Rescue Line
- Rescue Maze
- Rescue Simulation
- OnStage
- Soccer

Then pick a First Choice League (your primary preference) and a Second Choice League (your backup). If you are new to the international RoboCupJunior community, league committees may contact your Regional Representative for endorsement.

Role Interests

Tick all roles you would be interested in. Click "View Detailed Role Descriptions" for more information. Roles are grouped by league.

 Training *is* provided for technical roles. If a role requires prior experience, communicate this with your Regional Representative.



Availability

Click on the date tiles to toggle your availability. Green = available. Volunteers available for all days are given priority.

Travel & Symposium

- Attending the Symposium? — Toggle on if you will attend July 6 for presentations and networking.
- Travelling with a team? — Indicate if you are coordinating with a competition team. This is important if you are registering with them as a mentor or adult chaperone.
- Travelling with another volunteer? — Toggle if coordinating travel with a fellow volunteer
- Travel Plans — Describe your arrival/departure dates and travel arrangements

Support Requests

Toggle on any support you need. Note that travel costs (flights, buses, trains) are not covered — these are your responsibility.

- Registration Support — Free event registration is available for accepted volunteers who are not registering with teams.
- Visa Letter — A visa invitation letter can be requested.
- Accommodation Support — Private shared accommodation may be available for confirmed volunteers

What Happens Next?

After submitting, the RoboCupJunior Executive Committee will review all submissions and contact applicants via email. Allow several weeks for this process. Completing your application does not guarantee selection.

Confirmed volunteers receive:

- Free registration to RoboCup, including access to the RoboCup Symposium
- Training for their assigned volunteer role
- Networking opportunities with researchers, teams, and volunteers from around the world

i *Volunteers are responsible for their own travel and accommodation. If planning, book refundable accommodation until you receive confirmation.*
